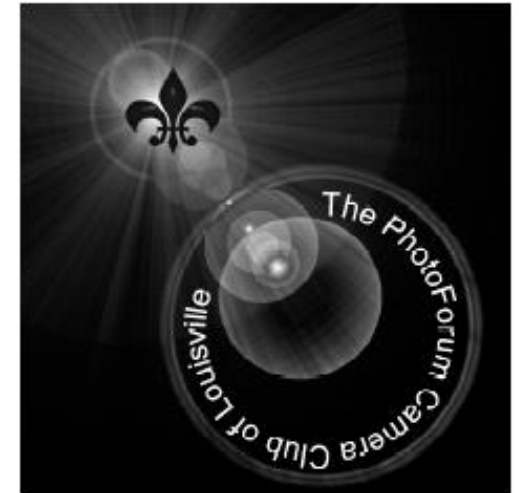

## Our Invitation

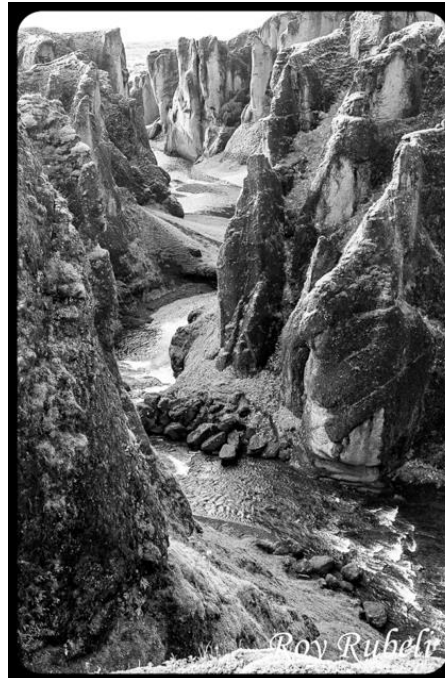

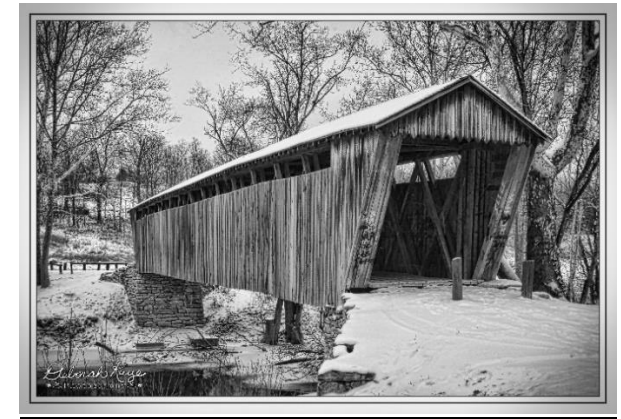
